# **LINDA HALVERSON** **MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

- The Linda Halverson Memorial Scholarship will be given annually to a graduating senior at Midway Public Public High School.
- The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,500.00 annually.
- Any graduating senior shall be eligible for the Linda Halverson memorial scholarship.
- Students who will be attending a four-year degree granting institution of higher learning and who plan to complete a four-year degree program shall have limited preference over students attending a one or two year college, vocational, technical, or trade school.
- Preference will be given to students who have been active in the high school music program at Midway Public School and/or will be involved in the music field while attending any of the above institutions.
- Preference will be given to applicants who through their participation in school activities show a desire and commitment to further their education.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have a definite need for financial support. The financial information sheet which is part of the application must be completed, signed and dated by all parties.
- The scholarship funds will be paid by a check payable to the appropriate institution of higher learning at fall semester registration time and will be issued from the Halverson Family Foundation. Any proceeds unused by the recipient at this institution shall be returned to the Halverson Family Foundation.
